

### Impact of Funding 2017/18

During the financial year 2017/18, Woodlands Community College was allocated funding of £261,760 for students who have claimed free school meals at any time in the past six years and this amounts to a Pupil Premium funding. We have set up a programme of events, which is repeated and adapted annually as we further understand the most successful strategies with our students.

Student progress is judged by the Contextual Progress 8 performance measure. This measure shows how students compared against similar students nationally using a variety of contextual measures. Despite being a negative figure of -0.22 this figure is substantially better than the contextual progress of those pupils who are not eligible for the Pupil Premium.
